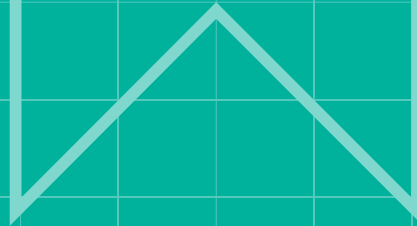

XXV TILE OF SPAIN AWARDS ARCHITECTURE & INTERIOR DESIGN

celebrating

1. Eligibility

The Competition is open to any individual, organisation or institution, either acting individually or as part of a team, provided that the requirements set out in these Terms and Conditions are met. Entries may be submitted on the participant's own initiative or at the invitation of the Award organiser.

The Awards are open to:

- Architects
- Interior designers
- Technical architects
- Landscape architects
- Decorators

Regardless of nationality.

2. Entry requirements

Projects shall be submitted under one of the following categories and subcategories:

- **Architecture:** New-build projects, refurbishment or renovation of existing buildings and façades, as well as urban regeneration and landscape projects. Projects submitted in this category must feature ceramic floor and/or wall tiles manufactured by ASCER member companies (see the [list of member companies & brands](#)). The Jury will give particular consideration to the way ceramic tiles have been integrated into the project and their contribution to the overall design.

Subcategory A-a: Architectural projects using dry-pressed porcelain tiles.

Subcategory A-b: Architectural projects using any of the following ceramic tile types: extruded porcelain tiles, rustic porcelain tiles, stoneware, glazed wall tiles, mosaics, terracotta, or other ceramic tile products.

- **Interiorismo:** New-build interior projects, refurbishment or renovation of existing interior spaces, as well as temporary installations and artistic interventions. Projects submitted in this category must integrate ceramic floor and/or wall tiles manufactured by ASCER member companies or brands (see the [list of member companies & brands](#)) into the interior design.

Subcategory I-a: Interior design projects using dry-pressed porcelain tiles.

Subcategoría I-b: Interior design projects using any of the following ceramic tile types: extruded porcelain tiles, rustic porcelain tiles, stoneware, glazed wall tiles, mosaics, terracotta, etc.

The following product types are not eligible for the Awards, as they are not represented by ASCER: ceramic blocks, insulated clay blocks, facing bricks, ceramic paving blocks, roof tiles, ceramic vaulting elements, handcrafted ceramic products, and hydraulic (cement) tiles.

Following the submission of entries and prior to their acceptance into the Awards, a technical committee appointed by ASCER will verify compliance with the requirements set out in these Terms and Conditions. The committee will reject any project where the ceramic products used are not manufactured by an ASCER member company or brand at the time of submission, where the use of ceramic tiles is merely incidental or does not form an integral part of the project's design, where the project fails to comply with these Terms and Conditions, or where the required documentation has not been duly submitted. The committee's decision shall be final and no appeal shall be permitted.

Following the technical committee's review, the Jury reserves the right to reclassify any project into a different category or subcategory.

The Awards are open to projects completed both in Spain and internationally.

Projects must have been completed between January 2024 and October 2026.

Projects submitted in previous editions of the Awards will not be accepted.

By entering the 25th Tile of Spain Awards of Architecture and Interior Design, participants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions and to accept the decisions of the Jury and, where applicable, the technical committee appointed by ASCER regarding any matter arising from the Awards. The decisions of the technical committee shall be final and shall not be subject to appeal.

Participation in the Awards constitutes full and unconditional acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

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3. Submission of entries

All documentation must be clearly identified with the project title and must not include the name of the author or authors.

Entries must be submitted by following three simple steps:

1. Access the Awards website and complete the [entry form](#). The information provided in the form will be used in subsequent communications as the project's title and author details.
2. A confirmation email will automatically be sent containing your project identification number and a WeTransfer link through which all the required documentation must be uploaded in a single **file named after the project title**.
3. Once the documentation has been submitted and downloaded, an automatic email will be sent confirming that it has been successfully received.

The ZIP file must include the following documentation:

- **Project description.** A brief description of the project (maximum 600 words, in PDF or Word format), clearly indicating the type of ceramic product used (product type and format), the surface or area where the ceramic tiles have been applied, and the manufacturer or brand. This document must be clearly identified with the project title.
- **Brief CV** of the architect/interior designer or the design practice, including full contact details: postal address, telephone number and email address.
- **PDF panels.** A single unprotected PDF containing 5 to 8 A3 panels with high-quality photographs illustrating the completed project, with particular emphasis on the application of ceramic tiles. Images must be of sufficient size and resolution to ensure clear viewing. It is essential to include **photographs showing how ceramic tiles have been used within the project**. In addition to photographs, the panels may include explanatory text and drawing details. The panels must be identified with the project title only and must not include the author's name (anonymous submission).
- **Images.** A folder containing all photographs of the completed project must be included in JPEG or TIFF format, with particular emphasis on images showing the use of ceramic tiles, together with a photograph of the author(s). All images must have a resolution of 300 DPI. A maximum of 10 images may be submitted.
- **Detailed drawing** of the ceramic tile installation.

**Applicants are advised to prepare all the required documentation in the ZIP folder before completing the [entry form](#) in order to avoid submission errors. The maximum file size for the ZIP folder is 2 GB.*

Following the technical committee's review, applicants whose projects do not comply with these Terms and Conditions or whose submissions are incomplete will be notified by email.

4. Awards

Architecture A-a: €8.000 Interior Design I-a: €8.000
Architecture A-b: €8.000 Interior Design I-b: €8.000

The prize amounts are subject to any applicable withholding taxes in accordance with the relevant tax legislation.

The Jury reserves the right to award up to **two Honourable Mentions** in either of the two categories (Architecture or Interior Design) to recognise projects which, although not awarded a prize, stand out among the entries.

Award-winning projects and those receiving an Honourable Mention will be featured in CERASPAÑA magazine and included in promotional materials related to the Awards, as well as in other publications and in the official Awards website (www.tileofspainawards.com). They may also be used in any other promotional activities organised by ASCER or on its social media channels.

The Jury reserves the right to select as many finalist projects as it deems appropriate. These projects will be featured on the official Awards website and in other publications relating to the Awards.

5. Jury

The Jury shall act in accordance with these Terms and Conditions and shall be responsible for:

- The Jury's decision shall be recorded in the official record, together with the reasons on which it is based. Any member of the Jury may request that the reasons for their individual vote be recorded separately.

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The Jury shall act as a collegiate body and shall determine the winners by majority vote. If a member of the Jury is also the author or co-author of a shortlisted project, they may participate in the voting on all other projects but shall not vote on their own.

The Awards may not be declared void or awarded jointly (ex aequo).

The Jury reserves the right to reclassify submitted projects.

All decisions of the Jury shall be final and not subject to appeal.

6. Schedule and submission deadline

Entries and supporting documentation must be submitted via WeTransfer to ASCER at premios@ascer.es, in accordance with the procedure described in Section 3 of these Terms and Conditions.

The submission deadline is **22 October at 23:59 (CEST)**.
